2011 Bossy Bingo Tournament Rules

1. Teams will consist of three or four players. (**NO COED TEAMS**) Teams may compete with less than three players.
2. Scoring:
1 point for baskets inside 3-point line
2 points for baskets outside 3-point line
3. Players will participate in the highest grade of the player entering in the 2011/12 school year.
4. Games will be 15 points or 15 minutes. Ties will be sudden death; first basket wins. Possession will be decided by a coin flip called by the team who scores last.
5. One 1-minute time out per team, per game.
6. **28.5 balls will be used by all girls and boys up to and including 6th graders.**
7. All turnovers, steals, and defensive rebounds must be taken out beyond the free throw line extended before being put in play.
8. Ball must be checked into play on dead balls, made baskets or fouls.
9. Starting with the 6th team foul, the fouled team will shoot one free throw. If missed, team retains possession, if made, opponents will receive ball.
10. Flagrant or intentional fouls will result in one point and possession.
11. Jump balls will be awarded to the defensive team.
12. Fighting or swearing will result in disqualification of the individual from the tournament.
13. Players may be required to verify 2011/12 grade.
14. A complete set of rules will be sent to the team captain when bracketing has been completed via e-mail.

Official Bossy Bingo 3 on 3 Tournament Rules

1. Teams will consist of 3 or 4 players (NO co-ed teams) - teams may compete with less than three players. Players can only be on one roster, no changes once registered at tournament.
2. Players may play up in age. Discretion will be used by the scheduling committee on players close to the cut off age. Parents signature is needed on all participants.
3. Games will be 15 points - with a 15-minute time limit. If time has expired, team leading will be declared the winner. Ties will be sudden death, first basket wins - coin flip to start (last team to score calls flip).
4. Scoring: 1 point for baskets inside the three point line.
2 points for baskets outside the three point line
5. One 1-minute time out per team, per game. Clock will stop.
6. 28.5 ball will be used by all girls. Boys will use a 28.5 ball up to and including 6th graders.
7. All turnovers, steals and defensive rebounds must be "taken back" beyond the free throw line extended before being put in play. Violations will result in loss of points scored and possession change.
All take backs will be uncontested! (4) Warnings will be given, after that (1) point will be taken away from the team violating this rule, possession will remain with the team that had possession.
8. Ball must be checked into play on made baskets, fouls, and dead balls at the top of the court. The offensive player must pass the ball in while standing **STATIONARY out-of-bounds - 5 second rule will be ENFORCED. The defensive player can NOT cross the OUT-OF-BOUNDS line - (1) warning will be given than technical foul will be called with one point awarded to team with ball and will maintain possession.** The ball will need to be given to the defensive player in a sportsmanship manner.
9. Starting with the 6th team foul, (except on shooting fouls, which will start at the first foul) one free throw will be awarded. The fouled team may choose a one or two point attempt. (see rule #11)
10. All jump balls are awarded to the defensive team.
11. A player fouled in the act of shooting (whether inside or outside the three point area) and the shot was missed can choose to shoot a one or two point free throw shot.
 - if one point free throw shot is missed no points are awarded and offensive team keeps possession
 - if one point free throw shot is made one point is awarded and possession changes
 - if two point free throw shot is made two points are awarded and possession changes
 - if two point free throw shot is missed no points are awarded and possession changes
12. A player fouled in the act of shooting and the shot was made, the points count and player must shoot a "one" point free throw. Possession changes whether free throw shot is made or missed. This includes whether the shot was made inside or outside the three point area.
13. Flagrant or intentional fouls will result in one point and possession. Fighting or swearing will result in disqualification of the individual from the tournament.
14. Players may be required to verify 2011/12 grade. Please bring report cards.
15. The tournament committee asks that all involved whether players or parents be on their best behavior. All personnel working the tournament are volunteers and are donating their time for your enjoyment.
