DEAR PARENTS:

With the growing trend throughout the United States in the increase costs of sports and extra-curricular activities at the school level, the Howards Grove Boosters would like to cordially invite you to become part of an organization striving to provide our student athletes with opportunities to participate while keeping their parents' financial portion to a minimum, provide our community with financial contributions, and provide the students of the Howards Grove School District the opportunity to participate in athletic activities.

The Howards Grove Boosters have been running our school tournaments for 15 years. This is our main fundraiser, allowing us to donate over \$170,000 to our schools, teams and community since 1995. Last year, we donated over \$5,000 for youth basketball tournaments grades 4th through 8th, another \$2,500 for the high school freshman, JV, and varsity basketball leagues, both girls and boys, as well as girls' volleyball leagues. Lastly, we donated \$10,000 to Howards Grove High School for the new weight room. In 2008, we donated \$5000 to Northview Elementary School for its playground project, purchased a piano for the Howards Grove Middle School Music Department in 2005, and donated \$1250 to the Junior football program for new equipment which the player's wear. Last year, we were able to bring back the Tiny Tigers Basketball program, after a year's absence, at the request of many parents.

Additionally, we donate \$4,000 every year to put our high school athletes in new uniforms. (Each sport is on a revolving cycle for uniform replacement.) Annually, \$3,000 is given to the high school Letter Club to purchase certificates, letters, chevrons, and pins for athletes in the sports in which they have lettered.

As the Howards Grove School District's budget tightens each year, it is important to our community and our kids to have a Booster Club like ours, providing financial resources to our schools so that our student athletes are given the best opportunity to succeed. Without this help, the cost would either be passed onto parents or activities would be cancelled.
